Arrival and Dismissal

Bus Rider

- Every student at WFES is a bus rider we have no walking areas
 - Except for special circumstances approved through Central Office
- We encourage students to ride the bus carpool gets very long
- Students will get a Bus Tag on their backpack indicating their transportation Bus Number, Before/After Care, etc. **Please DO NOT remove
- Please try to keep PM transportation consistent multiple "ways" a child leaves school in a week can be challenging to students and staff

Car Rider - Follow Staff Directions



- Use side access road "Circle Drive" by Rt. 144- Pull all the way up to end of sidewalk
- Be READY to unload and load
- Adults <u>DO NOT</u> get out of your car
- Student should be able to fasten seat belt independently staff can not secure children in their car-seats or seats
- <u>DO NOT</u> pass cars in line



Arrival and Dismissal

- Early Dismissals
 - Changes for dismissal a note **MUST** come to the Front Office
 - **■** DO NOT email Teachers or Front Office
 - Dismissal Changes during the school day Call the Front Office by 3:15pm. Please do not make dismissal changes after 3:15pm unless it is an EMERGENCY
 - Early dismissals pick up by 3:15pm

Late Arrivals

- Students MUST be walked into the Front Office by an adult if they are late
- Be Patient during the 1st and 2nd weeks of school be at your stop earlier than noted buses may arrive at stops/leave school earlier or later as they learn routes
- Issues with buses parents will be notified through SchoolMessenger (take phone to bus stop)

What is PBIS?

PBIS (Positive Behavioral Interventions and Supports) is a process for creating safer and more effective schools. The process focuses on improving a school's ability to teach and support positive behavior for all students by developing research-based, school-wide, and classroom discipline systems. WFES designs, implements and evaluates effective school-wide procedures and processes intended for:

- ALL students
- ALL staff
- ALL settings

EXPECTATIONS WFES has three school-wide behavior expectations that are reinforced daily in all areas of the school. Be Respectful Be Responsible Be Ready to Learn As the expectations are followed, students are recognized for their efforts by receiving and participating in positive classroom and school-wide incentives and celebrations, receiving Tiger Tickets, using Tiger tickets to purchase from the PBIS cart, engaging in monthly/quarterly celebrations, receiving the Golden Ticket, and having their picture taken for our Golden Ticket bulletin board.

All students begin every day with Super Behavior. If a student needs assistance Parents can become following the expectations, then involved at home by: the following sequence of consequences is followed: 1st Reminder 2nd Reminder 3rd Reminder - take a break 4th Reminder - student completes a Tiger Report (copy sent home with parent notification) Administrative Involvement (student receives an office referral) Certain behaviors, for example, fighting

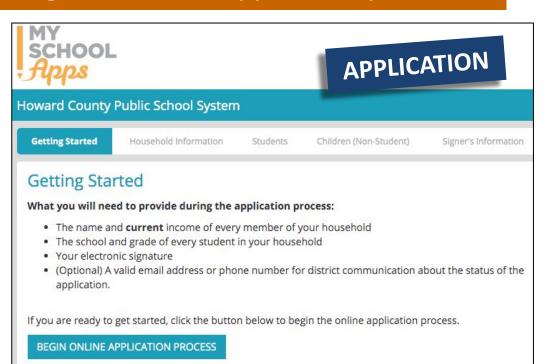

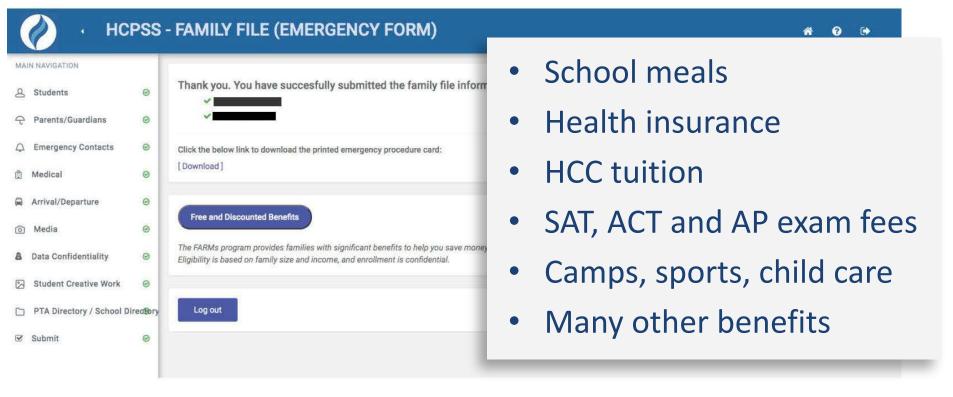


