2022-23 School Start/End Times & Bus Schedules

West Friendship's student hours are **9:15am-3:45pm**. Students who are car riders may not be dropped off at school earlier than 9:05am. All students must be in their classrooms before the late bell rings at 9:15am. If you arrive after the 9:15am bell, you will need to accompany your child into the building to sign them in at the Front Office so they can obtain a tardy slip before reporting to class.

The HCPSS Pupil Transportation Office is still working on bus route and bus stop information based on countywide enrollment. Bus information, including your child's assigned bus number, bus stop location, and morning pickup and afternoon drop off times **will be available on August 23rd** via [HCPSS website](https://www.hcpss.edu/).

At the beginning of the year, it is recommended that you arrive at the bus stop 10-15 minutes earlier than the posted time, to ensure that you do not miss the bus. As bus drivers learn their new routes and acclimate to school-year traffic, it is common for buses to run a bit behind schedule at the beginning of the year.

UPDATE YOUR EMERGENCY CONTACT INFO ASAP

The 2022-2023 Family File is now available to parents. Parents who have updated their Family File emergency cards will be able to log in to HCPSS Connect on Wednesday, August 24 to view homeroom teacher assignments. Once you have saved the information for the 2022-2023 school year and provided your electronic signature, your Family File will be updated.

Every year HCPSS parents must complete a Family File for each child. HCPSS utilizes Family File for parents/guardians to complete emergency information. Parents/guardians must verify and/or update information for each child, and can do so by logging in to [HCPSS Connect](#) via your **PARENT ACCOUNT**, select the MORE OPTIONS tab on the left and then on Family File.

Once logged in, you will be asked to update or provide the following information:

- Student Information
- Parent/Guardian Contact
- Emergency Contacts
- Medical Information
- Arrival/Dismissal Procedures
- Photo Approval Data Confidentiality (this is important if you want your child to appear in the yearbook or in team/activity postings)
- PTA/PTSA Directory

Again, it is imperative that you complete the Family File as this is the only way to access your child's teacher assignment prior to Open House on August 26th. For confidentiality reasons, we are not able to share teacher assignments over the telephone.

Common Roadblocks to Successfully Updating the Family File:

- You can now reset your password with or without a security Q & A. So, if you've tried to update and hit a roadblock, please try again.
- If you are having trouble remembering your username (which is the full email address of a parent/guardian), call or email us and we will let you know what you should be using to access the initial time. Please note: You cannot complete this task using the student login/account. It can only be completed by using a parent/guardian account.
- Families new to HCPSS should receive an authorization key in your email. Follow those instructions.
- If you have requested a reset, and have not received an email, we need you to check your junk or SPAM folders. That seems to be where many of these emails are ending up. If you still do not have it, give us a call.

All families must update their emergency contact information annually. While we recognize many of you may not have any changes to make, you must click through each of the screens, then click submit for this task completed. Some sections require annual permission, such as permission to photograph your student, for example (this is important if you want your student in team/activity postings).

School Meals 2022-2023

Families are reminded that the **federal government has NOT extended waivers allowing free meals for all students**. Consequently, for the 2022-2023 school year, students whose families do not qualify for free or reduced lunch will be required to pay the daily meal price:

- Student Breakfast - \$2.00
- Free/Reduced Breakfast \$0 ([Find out more about FARMS here](#))
- Student Lunch - \$2.80
- Free/Reduced Lunch - \$0 ([Find out more about FARMS here](#))
- Milk only (1/2 pint) - \$.50

Many HCPSS families are eligible to participate in the [Free and Reduced Price Meals \(FARMS\) program](#), which provides children with a wide range of benefits including free or discounted college tuition, testing and application fees, academic and athletic program fees and many others in addition to free or discounted meals.

Families are urged to check their eligibility and complete a FARMS application as soon as possible. Families must submit a new application every school year.

Temporary Employee Position

Student Medication Drop-Off

If your child requires medication (prescription or over the counter) during the upcoming 2022-2023 school year, your child's health care provider must complete a [medication form](#) and/or an [Epi-Pen Care](#) form. All prescribed medications must be in properly labeled containers that include the following information:

- Student name
- Medication name
- Dose to be given
- Time & Frequency of medication
- Prescriber's name & signature
- Date of medication order

Pharmacy labels will usually contain this information. Over-the-counter medications should be in new, unopened containers labeled with the student's name.
