What Should I Bring Everyday

Daily Student Items:

- Face mask
- Headphones
- Personally labeled water bottle
- Personally labeled school materials in a pouch such as pencils, scissors, glue, crayons, etc.
- Paper copies of kindergarten supplies is available

Optional Items:

- Personal hand sanitizer, tissues, and wipes
- 2-3 labeled favorite personal books for independent reading
- Change of clothes/light jacket

Arrival and Dismissal

Bus Rider

- Every student at WFES is a bus rider we have no walking areas
 - Except for special circumstances approved through Central Office
- Encouraged to have students ride the bus carpool gets very long
- Students will get a Bus Tag on their backpack indicating their transportation - Bus Number, Before/After Care, etc.
- Please try to keep PM transportation consistent multiple "ways" a child leaves school in a week can be challenging to students and staff

Car Rider - Follow Staff Directions



- O Side access road "Circle Drive" Pull all the way up to end of sidewalk
- Be READY to unload and load
- <u>DO NOT</u> get out of your car
- Student should be able to fasten seat belt independently staff can not secure children in their car-seats or seats
- <u>DO NOT</u> pass cars in line

**Please let us know how your child should go home. There is a sticky note on each child's name tag. Please indicate if your child will go home by bus, car, or will stay for After Care.

Arrival and Dismissal

Early Dismissals

- Changes note **MUST** come to the Front Office
 - DO NOT email Teachers or Front Office
 - Dismissal Changes during the school day Front Office needs to be notified by 3:15pm. Please do not make dismissal changes after 3:15pm unless it is an EMERGENCY
- Early dismissals pick up by 3:30pm

Late Arrivals

- Be Patient during the 1st and 2nd weeks of school be at your stop earlier than noted - buses may arrive at stops/leave school earlier or later as they learn routes
- Issues with buses parents will be notified through SchoolMessenger (take phone to bus stop)



First Day Jitters

Teachers meet the students outside as they come off the buses.

- •We walk the students directly to their buses or to circle drive at the end of the day.
- •Other staff members will be helping and directing your students to where they need to be with friendly faces!
- •Please label all school supplies and personal items such as backpacks, lunch boxes, jackets, sweatshirts, etc.
- •Please send an extra pair of clothes in a plastic bag labeled with your child's name. This will be kept in their backpack.

Using the Bathrooms and Water Fountains

- You should bring a reusable water bottle and use the water fountain to refill when you are thirsty
- Kindergarten Rooms have a bathroom (except Mrs. Farrar they use bathrooms across from the Media Center)

Signs are posted in the bathroom with reminders to wash your hands

Breakfast and Lunch

- Breakfast served every day between 9:00 9:15
 - Free to all students
- Lunch
 - Lunch is free for all students, but you may also bring your own lunch
 - Lunch Menu is located on HCPSS website
 - Students will sit in an assigned seat by homerooms
 - Raise your hand if you need help
 - Put your mask on when you finish eating your meal
 - Outdoor Dining will be available to students
 - weather and staff dependent
 - rotating basis will occur if capacity is exceeded

Recess

- We will have outdoor recess as much as possible!
- We will have 3 play areas using the playground, blacktop, and field.
- Remember to label your jackets and hats
- For indoor recess, students will play at centers, read or color
- Masks are optional to wear while outdoors

What happens if I feel sick at school?

- If you are not feeling well, you will visit the nurse's office
- A nurse will check your temperature and ask about the problem
- If you are sick and need to go home, you will wait in the health room until a parent/guardian comes to pick you up
- You can return to school once you feel better and fever free for 24hrs

Illness / COVID Symptom Self-Check

A student should NOT come to school with any of these symptoms:

- fever of 100.4 degrees or higher
- sore throat
- cough
- difficulty breathing
- diarrhea or vomiting
- new onset of severe headache (especially with fever), or
- new loss of taste or smell

For persons with chronic conditions such as asthma, the symptoms should represent a change from baseline.
