## **Map Testing Announcement**

On Wednesday, October 7 and 14, students in grades 2-8 will take the Measured Academic Progress (MAP) assessment. The data from the MAP assessment will help schools and teachers measure where your child is starting the year academically. The HCPSS intends to also give the assessment in winter and spring to measure how your child's learning is progressing throughout the year. The MAP test does not affect grades and the difficulty adjusts depending on how your child responds. It is normal for students to only answer about half the questions correctly. The Reading test will be offered on October 7 at 9 am and 1 pm. The Math test will be offered on October 14 at 9am and 1pm. Students may choose to attend either the morning or afternoon session. If your child is unable to attend, makeup testing will be offered during asynchronous learning times. Teachers will share Google Meet information and your student's testing group as we get closer to the Oct 7<sup>th</sup> date. It is required that all families, including returning families, verify or update information for every child in the family, every school year. Please Note: Although schools remain virtual through 1/28/21, it is important that we have up-to-date emergency contact information for each student, in the event that our staff need to communicate directly with our families. - Parents who have forgotten their login credentials may click the "Forgot Password" link on the sign-in page.
- If a parent completed the Family File **prior** to <u>August 10<sup>th</sup></u>, the information entered was attached to the 2019-2020 school year and the Family File will be considered incomplete.

## HCPSS 2020 Seasonal Flu Vaccine Clinics – Register by September 30

Due to the Covid-19 pandemic, obtaining a vaccine for seasonal influenza (flu) is even more important this year than ever. HCPSS Health Services is continuing its partnership with the Howard County Health Department (HCHD) and the Maryland Partnership for Prevention (MPP) to offer several regional seasonal flu vaccine clinics for HCPSS students and staff during the month of October. The clinic dates are October 7-14. The clinics will be held at 24 school sites, outdoors, from 4:00-6:00 p.m., and ANY HCPSS student or staff may attend ANY clinic they wish; pre-registration with appointments will be required. Registration closes on Wednesday, September 30<sup>th</sup>. Register at <a href="https://www.vaccineconsent.com">www.vaccineconsent.com</a> (Links to an external site.) and search by location for flu clinics. The dates and sites are as follows:

The clinics will be held outside and will be drive-up clinics. Students and staff may stay in their car when they are vaccinated, or they can sit outside at a table if they walk up. All parties will be required to use appropriate PPE and all social distancing measures will be employed. Please contact our School Nurse, Mrs. Collora if you have questions.

HCPSS News emails and text alerts keep families up-to-date on news and events, and delivers real-time notices of emergency closings and information. All HCPSS News subscriptions are generated from the information provided in Family File and have been automatically updated for the 2020-2021 school year. Parents/guardians new to the system are automatically enrolled for email notification, and must opt in to text alerts.

#### **School Calendar**

Make sure you know important dates on the <u>2020-2021 academic calendar</u>. There are no printed calendars; you may view the online calendar and/or download printable calendar PDFs on our website. The calendar is subject to change.

#### **Food Services**

Meals will be provided at no cost to any HCPSS student, and are available to all children 18 and under, through December 31, 2020, subject to U.S. Department of Agriculture funding availability.

West Friendship Elementary is a food distribution site. The <u>food services</u> <u>program</u> during the first semester of the 2020-2021 school year will consist of Grab-n-Go breakfasts and lunches served Monday through Friday from 8–9 a.m. and 10:45 a.m.–12:45 p.m.

Parents of students who qualify for Free and Reduced-Price Meals (FARMs) must submit a new application every school year. View <u>program details</u> and learn how to apply. HCPSS participates in the National School Lunch and Breakfast Programs which provide families with significant benefits to help save money. Qualification is based on family size and income, and enrollment is confidential. All children in households receiving benefits from the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) can get free meals regardless of income, and students from households that meet federal income guidelines are eligible to receive free or reduced-price meals. Those eligible for reduced-price meals pay \$0.10 for breakfast and \$0.20 for lunch. We'd like to encourage you to participate in these programs as needed.

A change of Address cannot be made through Family File. If you have recently moved, please contact your child's new school as soon as possible. As we are preparing for the upcoming 2020-2021 School Year, it is imperative that we have accurate addresses on file for all of our students.
