# **Absences and Late Arrivals**

Parents are required to send a note to school explaining their child's absence when the student returns to school. The note must include the student's name, the date of the absence, and the reason for absence. In cases of three consecutive days of absence or frequent absence, a doctor's certificate is required.

When arriving to school late, the student, accompanied by a parent/guardian, must report to the office for a late pass before he/she will be admitted to class.

# **Dismissal Arrangements**

Please be advised that notes are needed if you want your child to follow a different dismissal arrangement. Telling a student of a dismissal change is not satisfactory. Notes <u>must</u> be sent to school if you wish for your child to be dismissed to Circle Drive or attend an afterschool activity. Please <u>do not</u> <u>email</u> this information. If our Internet is not working or if a teacher has a substitute, your message will not be received in a timely manner. Arrangements via telephone will only be honored in the event of an emergency. Please remember that students are not permitted to ride any bus other than their assigned bus. Thank you for helping us keep our students safe.
