# From the Principal's Desk

Thank you to all the families who have completed their on-line emergency cards using HCPSS Connect. Currently we are at 68% completion and we truly need 100% of our families to confirm the information. Your child's safety is our number one priority. Please call the main office if you need any assistance. While on the subject of safety, we practiced our emergency lock down procedure school wide this week. Throughout the year we will continue to practice a variety of emergency procedures to ensure we are all safe. If you are volunteering or visiting on the day of a practice, you are expected to fully participate.

Another upgrade to our building security will be access to classrooms after school hours. All classrooms are secured when students leave for the day. This is to ensure that our equipment and resources are protected and any student information is kept confidential. Often parents and students return to school to retrieve a variety of materials. This will no longer be permitted. Responsibility is one of our PBIS 3 R's. This is something that we teach regularly throughout the day. I recommend that your child identify a classmate they could call if they forget a homework assignment. If it is an essential item that must be retrieved from the classroom like eyeglasses, you will need to report to the main office for assistance. I appreciate your understanding in this manner.

#### This week's Math at Home:

What is your favorite board game? This week's problems are based on popular board games that you may have played or have at least heard of.

**K-Grade 2**: Asia and Adeline are playing Hi Ho Cherry- $0^{\text{TM}}$ . Asia has 5 cherries in her bucket and needs a total of 10 cherries to win. On any spin, she could collect 1, 2, 3, or 4 cherries, or she could lose 1, 2, or all of the cherries. List 5 ways in which Asia can win the game in just three turns. Find 5 ways she can win the game in 4 turns. Use pictures, numbers or words to show your work.

\*Parents- use items such as cereal pieces or beans to help your child act out the problem.


**Grade 3-4**: Olivia and her family began playing Scrabble® at 4:30 p.m. They took a break to eat a snack at 5:15 p.m. and resumed playing at 5:30 p.m. They finished their game at 6:05. How long did Nora and her family play Scrabble (not including the break)? Express you answer in hours and minutes. Explain your strategy. How many seconds did Nora and her family play Scrabble? Explain your strategy.

**Grade 5**: Each Monopoly® player starts with \$1,500. The game includes bills in the following denominations: \$1, \$5, \$10, \$20, \$50, \$100, and \$500. Assuming that you have an unlimited amount of each denomination, show the different ways you could make \$1,500 using exactly 10 bills. Compare your answers to a family member's. Discuss similarities and differences.
