Chromebooks for Fall

- Beginning August 10, 2020, families with students new to HCPSS and whose registration has been finalized will receive an email from noreply@hcpss.org with the subject "Technology account information for new HCPSS students." The email will be sent to the email address used during the student registration process. The email contains personalized and important information regarding new students' technology accounts. If you have a child new to HCPSS and do not receive the email and/or cannot locate the email in the junk/spam folder of the email account you used during registration, you can use the Forgot Password or Username button on the hcpss.me student landing page to retrieve both your child's username and password. Directions for Account Self Service are posted online.
- Students who will attend an HCPSS school for the 2020-2021 school year and who borrowed an HCPSS Chromebook in the spring or summer may continue to use the device for the 2020-2021 school year. There will be more information coming soon if you need to borrow a Chromebook for the upcoming year.
- Students leaving HCPSS after the 2019-2020 school year and/or who have withdrawn from the 2020-2021 school year will need to return a borrowed Chromebook and/or hot spot either during the designated time provided by their current school's collection time (schedule will be shared soon) or within a week of the student's last day of enrollment and completion of coursework. Students who will return a Chromebook/hot spot outside their school's designated time will need to bring the device to the HCPSS Logistics Center (9645 Gerwig Lane, Columbia). The building is open weekdays from 9-11 a.m.

School Supplies

We are currently working with Central Office as they develop a revised school supply list that is appropriate for online learning. While there will be some items from the traditional supply list, there will likely be some additions. Information will be sent out when this list is complete.

Collection and Distribution of Materials

- We are currently working on procedures/schedules to collect items from the 19-20 school year AND procedures/schedules to distribute items/materials for the 20-21 school year. Collection and distribution will occur within the next 2-3 weeks - specific information will be coming out soon.
- 19-20 Pick-up of Protect the Ocean T-Shirts
- Collection of Materials from the 19-20 School Year could include items such as: text books, instruments, media books, Chromebook if leaving HCPSS
- **Distribution of Materials** for the 20-21 school year will include items such as: bundled consumable curriculum materials for Art, PE, Science and other curricular areas, instruments, etc.

Learning at Home Tips

- Below are some tips that you may find helpful or useful as you prepare your child for this year of learning. We recognize that all families are at a different place at this time in terms of school readiness, but for those of you who are curious as to ways you can support your child, we have compiled a beginning list for you.
- Provide a designated learning space for your child. This will help your child with understanding that school is important. If your child has their own area that is strictly for their schooling, they are less likely to be distracted and it will help your child get in the zone for learning. This can be a small table, a small tv tray, a corner table in a kitchen, etc. Please do whatever works best for you, however, we recommend that this area has a "permanent" spot in the house.
- Within the designated space, have organized items that your child will be able to find, put away and use. This will allow students to work in their area without needing to leave it to find needed materials.
- School box or bin for crayons, pencils, scissors, glue and markers
- Headphones are helpful to avoid distractions to others AND they will block out distractions from the house
- Small whiteboard or thick paper in sheet protectors and black expo markers.
 Often teachers will ask your child to hold up their work and paper can be hard to see in an online format.

Family File

- It is required that all families, including returning families, verify or update information for every child in the family, every school year. Please Note: Although schools remain virtual through 1/28/21, it is important that we have upto-date emergency contact information for each student, in the event that our staff need to communicate directly with our families.
- You can access the Family File by logging in to the <u>HCPSS Connect</u> at <u>www.hcpss.org/connect/</u>. Parents who are new to the Howard County Public School System will receive a welcome email with instructions on how to activate an account. Once you have logged into the <u>HCPSS Connect</u>, select the Family File tab on the left-hand side, and then select the blue underlined "Family File"

towards the center of your screen. Once logged in, parents/guardians will be asked to provide, update, or confirm the following information:

- Student Information
- Parent/guardian Contact Information
- Emergency Contacts
- Medical Information
- Media Release (photo approval)
- Data Confidentiality
- PTA/PTSA Directory
- Please note, if the section you are looking for is not allowing you to move forward, then there is a question/checkbox on that page that may still need to be addressed. Please make sure to re the prompts at the top of each tab, and click to expand each section. Assistance is available at this link.
- Parents who have forgotten their login credentials may click the "Forgot Password" link on the sign-in page.
- If a parent completed the Family File **prior** to <u>August 10th</u>, the information entered will be attached to the 2019-2020 school year and the Family File will be considered incomplete.

Change of Address

- A change of Address cannot be made through Family File. If you have recently
 moved, please contact your child's new school as soon as possible. As we are
 preparing for the upcoming 2020-2021 School Year, it is imperative that we have
 accurate addresses on file for all of our students. If you have moved, and have
 not provided us with your updated information, we ask that you email the

- A completed change of address form
- A copy of your new lease or deed
- A copy of a current utility bill with your new address
